**History:** Baby Of RAMYA SRI is a term (38 weeks + 6 days) baby boy, delivered to a primi mother by elective LSCS on 12.07.2026 at 12:47 Pm with birth weight of 2.620 kgs in Rainbow Children's Hospital, Himayatnagar, Hyderabad. Baby cried immediately after birth. Apgar scores were 9/10 at 1 min, 10/10 at 5 min. Inj. Vitamin K 1mg IM was given after delivery. Delayed cord clamping done. Fetal presentation was Vertex.

**Maternal History:** Mrs. RAMYA SRI is a 33 years old primi mother. G1 - Present pregnancy, IVF conception, had regular Antenatal checkup's, received 2 doses of Injection. Tetanus Toxoid. Antenatal scans were normal. H/O: Gestational Diabetes Mellitus. No history of Pregnancy Induced hypertension/ Urinary Tract Infection/ Antepartum Haemorrhage/ Hypothyroidism/ / Oligohydramnios/ Polyhydramnios/ Prolonged Rupture Of Membranes/ Fever.

**Mother's Blood group is O positive. Baby's blood group is B positive.**

**Examination:** Baby was euthermic (36.5 \*C), euvolemic and was maintaining

saturations at room air. On auscultation of chest, air entry was bilaterally equal with normal heart sounds. Bilateral femoral pulses well felt. Abdomen was soft with no organomegaly. Cry and activity were good. Anterior fontanelle was at level. No obvious external congenital anomalies were noted clinically. All external orifices were patent and open. All neonatal reflexes were normal.

**Management:**

**Course during hospital:**

Serum bilirubin at 48 hours of life was 12.7 mg/dl with indirect fraction of 12.6 mg/dl. Hence double surface phototherapy (DSPT) was started. Repeat SBR on following day was 8.4 mg/dl with indirect fraction of 8.3 mg/dl. Hence, phototherapy was stopped. In view of IDM mother, serial glucose levels monitoring was done, which was in borderline. Hence, advised for formula feeds.

Baby tolerating feeds well, hemodynamically stable, passed urine and meconium, hence being discharged with the following advice.

**Condition at discharge:** Baby is pink, warm, active and on direct breast feeds + measured feeds.

**Review back to Hospital:** If baby is not feeding continuously for > 6 hours, If breathing fast, Fever or poor activity or lethargy, Bluish discolouration of lips, Increase in jaundice, Abnormal movements occurs.

- The Early Warning Score does not replace clinical experience and acumen and should not be relied upon for such purpose.
- 6 clinical parameters are assessed and recorded as part of the child's routine clinical observation, providing a Early Warning Score between 0-6 (Higher Early Warning Score are seen in sicker children)
- Detailed actions are described according to increasing Early Warning Score.
- Some children with complex medical needs e.g. cyanotic heart disease may require modification to their trigger thresholds/ action plan- this should follow discussion with senior colleagues.
- Any Early Warning Score of 3 or above should be recorded below with details of any subsequent action initiated

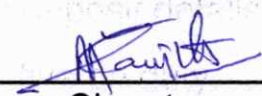
